Reverend J. Leighton Read, 18-year Norman resident, was the son of Rev. John J. Jeremiah Read, of Hinds To., Miss., and Lillah Pratt Porter, daughter of Rev. A. A. Porter of South Carolinaq Rev. Read celebrated his 20th birthlay September 14. He was born in Paris, Texas in 1879. 9-14-1879

He was appointed by the Foreign Mission Board of the Presbyterian Church in 1876 and served until 1881.

He ten entered full the evangelistic work in unoccupied territory among the Chickanaw Indiana and neitled near theold Wananucka Academy from which Wananucka, Mahoum not its name. Here Rev. Read grew up.

Reverend Real attended accordary school and college at Austin college, Sherman, fexas, where he graduated with a DA letree in 1301. In the fall of 1902, he entered the Austin 'reabyteman eminary at Austin, one of dix who formed the first class of that institution.

being ordained by the Quachita Presbytery in Schober 1905. He was pastor of the Gentral Presbyte Ian Church at Little Rock, Arkanaae from 1912-1917, when he received a call from the Board of Commentic Manions, Deformed Church in America, to the Colony, Oblahoma mission among the Cheyenne and Arapaho Indians. He pervel here six years and one transfer ed to the mission at Lawton among the Commenche and Apache Indians. He was married to the forer Katherine Fauchope of Firstnia in 1913.

In 1926, Real received thehonomy to rec of Doctor of Divinity from his alma mater, Austin College, Sherman, Texas.
